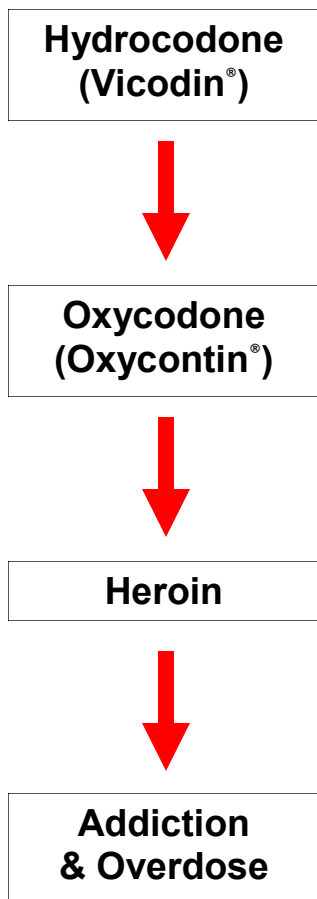




You Can Help Prevent Tragedy

In Livingston County from 2009 - 2010, 28 people died of heroin overdoses.
