Dear Parents and Community Members:

We are pleased to present you with the Annual Education Report (AER), which provides key information on the 2023-24 educational progress for Fowlerville Online Learning Academy (FOLA). The AER addresses the complex reporting information required by federal and state laws. The school's report contains information about student assessment, accountability, and teacher quality. For the 2024-25 school year, schools were identified based on previous years' performance using definitions and labels as required in the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). A Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI) school is one that had at least one underperforming student subgroup in 2023-24. An Additional Targeted Support (ATS) school is one that had a student subgroup performing at the same level as the lowest 5% of all schools in the state in 2021-22. A Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI) school is one whose performance was in the lowest 5% of all schools in the state, had a graduation rate at or below 67%, or failed to exit ATS status in 2021-22. Some schools are not identified with any of these labels. In these cases, no label is given.

Fowlerville Online Learning Academy was not identified as having one of these labels.

With the support of the Livingston Educational Service Agency, we have made social work services more available for students and have sought to proactively address anxiety, depression, and patterns of behavior that can affect students' lives both in and outside of school. Our mental health specialist offers support to both in person and online students through individual counseling and small groups.

The Capturing Kids' Hearts framework in place at both Fowlerville High School and Fowlerville Online Learning Academy is designed to help teachers and other school staff members better connect with students and engage them in learning.

At Fowlerville Online Learning Academy, we are proud to offer four tracks of learning to service K-12 students. At the High School level, students have the opportunity to engage in the Traditional Path or the Alternative Path. Both options provide students with an

expansive online learning course selection, with the support of an in-person lab monitored by two FOLA mentors. Course offerings are available through contacting us on our webpage. All paths have the end goal of high school graduation in a non-traditional setting.

Our families remain a top priority, and we are dedicated to providing opportunities for engagement both in person and online. FOLA lab mentors maintain regular weekly communication with students and parents, ensuring ongoing support and connection. Fowlerville Online Learning Academy students have access to many of the same enriching opportunities as traditional in-person students while benefiting from the flexibility of online learning. We are committed to keeping families connected to the school community, fostering a sense of belonging even in a virtual environment.
